Description: The intern assists the Conservation Board's interpretive naturalists with various duties, and plans and conducts duties related to: Nature interpretation; outdoor recreation and environmental education programs for a wide range of audiences; summer campground programs; special events; live animal care; display development and maintenance; staffing the nature center; writing articles and press releases. Interns complete a display project and original activity curriculum. Interns experience and assume tasks of increasing responsibility.



Requirements: Ability to communicate well, both verbally and in writing; must have enthusiasm for nature and interacting with people; experience in outdoor recreation activities and ability to obtain a chauffeur's license are preferred. Successful applicant must possess a current valid driver's license, and will undergo criminal background checks and a pre-employment physical.

Dates: The position begins in April, 2021 or as soon as possible in May, and will end in August, 2021. Approximately 40 hours/week, with some weekends and evenings.

Wage: \$10.50 - \$11.00 per hour
