

**Special Meeting**  
**Buchanan County Conservation Board**  
**August 27, 2019**

This special meeting was held to approve additional work at Iron Bridge Access. The urgency requiring a special meeting is a time constraint to make use of contract labor and equipment while still on site. The meeting was held at the Iron Bridge Access located between Independence and Quasqueton.

The meeting was called to order by Board President Loren Hamilton at 5 p.m. Other board members present: Anita Miller, Andy Crump, and Karen Stephenson. Others present: Director Dan Cohen, Assistant County Engineer Alex Davis, Larry Miller, neighbor to Iron Bridge Access Ron Sheldon, and local resident Wayne Peyton. Motion Crump/Stephenson to approve the agenda. All aye.

The group viewed the current state of the access and ramp project. There were questions regarding the new ramp and Sheldon's existing second driveway. Without full plans on site, the second driveway questions could not be answered during the meeting.

Sheldon and Peyton left the meeting.

The group viewed the west shoulder of Nolen Avenue adjacent to the access, and the east Nolen Avenue right-of-way between the two Grover Timber lots, for potential additional parking. A plan developed by Davis for additional parking, connecting to the ramp by a sidewalk, was reviewed by the Board. Cohen also provided the Board with a project budget and information from the current expenditure budget dedicated to the project.

Motion Crump/Miller to approve adding the additional parking and sidewalk as per Davis' plan and cost estimate. All aye.
