The dust control material used and the method of application must be acceptable to the County Engineer. Said materials shall not be applied in excess to cause a hazard to the driving public. If in the judgment of the County Engineer, the material used was put on in excess, the County will either sand or rock the area at the expense of the applicant to make the road safe to the driving public. The applicant agrees to reimburse the County for said sand or rock. Also, if any dust control material is found to be contaminated, the applicant agrees to pay the total cost of clean up.

YOU are responsible to notify the County Engineer's Office AT LEAST 3 working days (not including the weekend) prior to the application of said dust control so that the road can be inspected, and if needed, maintenance work can be performed.

All spots must have beginning and ending flags marking the area or we will blade through them.

At the discretion of the County Engineer or the Maintenance Superintendent, maintenance will be performed to the area treated as needed for the safety of the traveling public. The County will try to avoid disrupting the treated sections any more than necessary until approximately **October 1, 2016**. We do, however, reserve the right to blade the treated sections after a rain if the road conditions warrant and we will blade them again before the second application. **The owner is responsible for keeping the area free of potholes or the county may blade through it without notification.**

The applicant shall place a sign in advance warning of "fresh oil" or an appropriate warning for at least 24 hours.

Sand or pea rock shall be used to blot fresh vegetable oil.

The County shall tight blade the dust control spots as necessary.
