Maximum dimensions and weight allowed on an annual oversize/overweight permit is: Length - 100'. Width - 12'-5", Height - 14', Weight - 136,000 pounds

Carrier will be responsible for routing and checking with the department for updates prior to move. Permit is not valid for travel on interstate highways.

Carrier will receive a subscription to the Detour and Embargo Map and Bridge Embargo Map. Copies of the Vertical Clearance Map and Kip Maps will also be provided. It will be the responsibility of the carrier to route themselves around low clearances, construction projects, embargoed roads, and bridges. If carrier demonstrates inability to self-route, the permit will be denied.

Permits can be issued only for loads that are a single article that cannot be reasonably broken down to make it legal in size and weight.

All information applicable to a given permit is required and is public information. Failure to complete the application as required will result in denial of permit.
