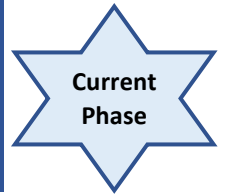

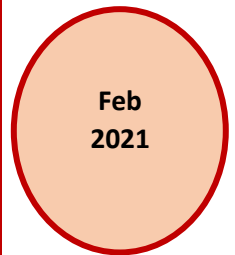

Prioritization factors within phase1B: * Historical COVID-19 disease trends affecting the eligible populations. The risk of exposure, the risk of transmission, the risk of complications, the frequency of exposure, and the duration of exposure from COVID-19 for the eligible populations. Considerations should include congregate settings, workplace environmental controls, population density, and other factors that may impact risk of exposure and transmission of COVID-19. Apply health equity considerations when prioritizing eligible populations.
